3 BICYCLISTS INJURED IN SR-1 CRASH

Davenport

On May 14, 2007, at approximately 12:10 pm, a 62 year old Woodside man was riding his bicycle southbound on SR-1 in the area of Cement Plant Road. The bicyclist lost control of his bicycle after driving over a set of train tracks. The bicyclist collided with the roadway. Two other riders, a 19 year old man from Pennsylvania and a 39 year old man from Colorado were unable to avoid the Woodside man. The two men collided with the Woodside man, causing them to be ejected from their bicycles.

All three bicyclists were wearing safety helmets which prevented more serious injuries. The 62 year old man was flown to a bay area hospital with major injuries to his leg. The other two bicyclists suffered minor abrasions.

This collision remains under investigation.
