Tool Available to Help Pedestrians

A Pedestrian Access Report program is available to Santa Cruz County residents. The report, developed by the Community Traffic Safety Coalition and the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission (SCCRTC), allows community members to report obstacles or hazards that may be encountered during pedestrian travel such as cracked sidewalks, sidewalks blocked by vehicles or overgrown vegetation. In addition the report can be used to indicate gaps in the sidewalk network and desired improvements.

The Pedestrian Access Report has been distributed to family resource and senior centers throughout the county. It is also available online at www.sctrafficsafety.org/safe_info.html and at www.commuterolutions.org/PAR.pdf. The completed report should be sent to the SCCRTC, mail: 1523 Pacific Avenue, Santa Cruz, CA 95060 or fax: 460-3215. The report will then be forwarded to the appropriate Public Works Department.
